Marisa Fratt has been with the City of Victorville for 18 years and was recruited to the Animal Care & Control team in 2011, starting as an Animal Control Dispatcher. Through the years she has moved through various positions and was promoted Animal Care & Control Supervisor in 2022. She has been instrumental in developing community outreach programs, maintaining data and reporting, and obtaining grants including the PAS grant which reduced barriers for the homeless individuals within our city allowing them to be sheltered with their animal and provides veterinary care, vaccinations, spay and neuter, food and housing for pets and their owners in the city's Wellness Center.

Most recently Marisa has been part of the team creating the City of Victorville's first animal shelter. In 2023, the shelter they had been contracted with since 1963 closed its doors with 30 days' notice. Along with her team, the development of an emergency animal shelter occurred in May 2023 using space the city already had. Through tremendous efforts and coordination, the permanent Victorville Animal Care & Adoption Center opened in December 2024.
